POOL HOURS

5/29/21 - 5/31/21: Memorial Day Weekend Pool Season OPEN Noon to 7:00pm

6/2/21 - 6/4/21: Spring Abbreviated Hours OPEN 4:00pm to 7:00pm

Normal Pool Hours of Operation:

6/9/21 - 8/15/21: Wednesday - Sunday OPEN Noon to 7:00pm

Mondays and Tuesdays: CLOSED

Fall Abbreviated Hours: OPEN from 4:00pm to 7:00pm

8/18/21 - 8/20/21; 8/25/21 - 8/27/21; 9/1/21 - 9/3/21

9/4/21 - 9/6/21: Labor Day Weekend Open Noon to 7:00pm

Pool Season Closes: Monday, September 6th at 5:00pm

ENTRY FOR MEMBERS

- Everyone must show his or her pass to Pool Attendant at the entry to the pool area.
- You are required to sign in with your last name, building address & unit number, and name(s) of children for which you are responsible. ONLY 2 guests are allowed per Adult tenant. Guest names MUST be listed on the sign in sheet along with the tenant name.
- Child Safety Rules:
 - Any child under the age of sixteen (16) must be accompanied by one of his/her parents or member eighteen (18) years of age or older.
 - No more than two (2) children allowed in the pool per one (1) accompanied adult.
 - Children must be supervised at all times by the adult responsible for the children including when the children are playing or swimming in any areas of the pool.
- Breaking any of these safety rules gives the lifeguard authority to ask violators to leave the pool immediately.

HEALTH

- Admission to the pool is refused to all persons having any contagious disease, infectious conditions such as colds, fever, ringworm, foot infections, skin lesions, carbuncles, boils, inflamed eyes, ear discharges, or any other condition which has the appearance of being infectious. Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions which have not healed, corn plasters, bunion pads, adhesive tape, rubber bandages, or other bandages of any kind may not be permitted.
- Any person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted into the pool area.
- A soapy shower in the nude must be taken before being allowed in the pool area. This applies to persons temporarily leaving the pool area for any reason (Illinois State Public Regulations).

- Wearing apparel other than swimsuits will not be allowed in the pool area (NO CUTOFFS).
- Women, girls and longhaired boys must wear bathing caps while in the pool. Caps must be worn until out of the water.
- Spitting, spouting water from the mouth and blowing the nose in the water are strictly forbidden.
- No smoking is permitted in the pool or on the pool decks. Also, no smoking will be permitted in the washrooms. Smoking will be permitted on the patio outside the fence area.
- Street clothes and shoes are expressly forbidden in the pool area.
- No food or beverages are permitted within 10 feet of the pool.

SAFETY

- No person will be permitted in the pool area unless an attendant is on duty. Social conversation with the attendants on duty is prohibited.
- No child under the age of sixteen (16) will be allowed in the deep end of the pool unless accompanied by one of his/her parents or a member eighteen (18) years of age or older.
- Breakable containers or hazardous objects may not be brought into the pool area. No objects will be allowed in the pool.
- Children in diapers are not allowed in the pool.
- Running, tag or ball games, pushing, dunking and horseplay are forbidden on the pool deck or in the water. Pushing or throwing persons from the pool edge is strictly prohibited.
- The rules and regulations are made to help you enjoy the pool and the Recreation Building to the fullest. They will be strictly enforced and we ask for your cooperation.
